Sailing Instructions

1. The start will be at the AHYC **S/F** mark (**lat:** 40 26.29 N, **long:** 074 02.11 W) in the Olympic circle.
2. Go to the Ambrose Buoy (RW”A”: **lat:** 40 27.48 N, **long:** 073 50.17 W) and do a port rounding. ***Buoys 11 & 13 in Sandy Hook Channel must be honored.***
3. Then return to the S/F mark. To finish, leave the S/F mark on your port side. Your boat must be within 50 feet of the S/F mark when finishing
