## **Sailing Instructions**

- 1. The start will be from the AHYC S/F mark in the Olympic circle to a windward mark (either JA, JB, JC, etc) depending on wind direction. The race committee will announce which mark and whether it will be a **port** or **starboard** rounding. *Buoys 11 & 13 in Sandy Hook Channel must be honored.*
- 2. From the windward mark go to the Scotland Light Buoy (RW"S": lat: 40 26.53, long: W 073 55.00) and do a port rounding. (lat/long are approx.)
- 3. Then return to the S/F mark. To finish, leave the S/F mark on your port side. The S/F buoy shall be on the **port** side of your boat and no more than fifty feef from your boat (see diagram on next page).
- **4.** Record your time of finishing and leave your finish time with boat name in the race committee box at the clubhouse or give it to John Pearson.
- 5. Any changes will be made on VHF Channel 69 prior to the start of the race.
