

Canoe & Kayak Boat Parade Instructions:

Canoes and Kayaks shall arrive at the 3800 W Lawther parking lot by 9:00am for an instructional meeting. The order of boats will be determined in that meeting. After the meeting please paddle to the north side of Jackson point and queue in that area by 9:45am. A Corinthian Sailing Club rescue boat will lead this wave of the parade. Please follow the next boat in the parade at a safe distance but stay as close as possible to maintain the continuity for the enjoyment of the viewers. There will be three viewing points: Jackson Point, Tee Pee Hill, and the Patio of the Filter Building. Each viewing point will have a series of buoys. Please paddle between all the buoys and the shore at each view point.

After you have passed the last viewing area, please paddle to the east shore of the lake to stay out of the way of the last wave of the parade (the wooden motor boats.) You may choose to paddle back to your launch point or you may choose to paddle to the Bath House and join the Beach Party of the Century. There is a \$15 dollar admission fee for the Beach Party. You can pull your boat out onto the grass outside the Beach Party fences.

It will hot out there. Please bring plenty of water, sunscreen, and necessary safety gear like life jackets for each individual, etc.
