Sailboat Boat Parade instructions:

Sailboats shall queue at the White Rock Boat Club (WRBC) at 9:00am. Please sail over to WRBC and attend the skippers meeting at 9:00am. After the skippers meeting the sailboats will be put in order along the docks as they will appear in the parade. At 9:50am boats will take off from the docks and head to Jackson Point. Sailboats will come close to shore and tack to port around the yellow mark at each watching point. There will be other, orange marks along shore, do not round any of the orange marks. Please follow a short, but safe distance, behind the next boat. The continuity of the line is important for the enjoyment of the viewers. The CSC committee boat will lead this wave of the parade. There will be three marks; the first mark is at Jackson Point; the second mark is at Tee Pee Hill, and the third is in front of the Filter building along the spillway. When you have completed the course, return to the sailing clubs along the east shore of the lake. Use extreme caution; there will be many boats on the water. The rowing shells will be queued in front of the Bath House. Be very cautious along that area, the shells have limited maneuverability cannot turn very quickly.
