1. GREETING LASER SAILORS!

Corinthian Sailing Club (CSC) is pleased to be the Organizing Authority and Host for the Rock the Ice District 15 Laser Regatta being held February 4-5, 2017. This is a two-day event for Lasers: Full (Standard), Radial and 4.7. This regatta combines a great sailboat, awesome sailors, terrific racing, a great venue and a warm delicious dinner.

We look forward to seeing you on a power-boat free White Rock Lake for the Rock the Ice Regatta!

2. Rules

The regatta will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing for 2017-2020 (herein after "RRS").

3. Eligibility

The regatta is open to all class legal Lasers with Full (Standard), Radial or 4.7 rigs. The regatta is open to all ages. Skippers who are under 20 years of age as of 12/31/2017 will be considered juniors. Competitors are not required to be members of ILCA, International Laser Class Association.

4. ENTRY and REGISTRATION

All persons who complete the registration and pay the registration fee will be eligible to compete in the regatta. Payments can be made online during the registration period. The entry fee is \$75.00 per entry. There is no early registration discount or late registration charge for this regatta. Complete the online entry form at <http://www.regattatech.com/events/CSC/LaserWinter17> or complete an entry form at check-in. Check-in and late Registration will be conducted on Saturday February 4, 2017 between 0800 and 0930 in the Corinthian Sailing Club's Club House. All sailors are required to check in by 0930 on Saturday at the registration table, even if the sailor pre-registered.

5. SCHEDULE

Subject to the decisions of the Race Committee, eight or more races are scheduled. One completed race will constitute a regatta. All times are listed as Central Standard Time, CST. The schedule will be as follows:

6. MEALS

Meals for the competitors are included in the entry fee. Additional meal packages will be \$30.00 per person. Meals included in the entry fee or meal packages consist of breakfast, lunch and dinner on Saturday plus a breakfast and lunch on Sunday.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be provided online and available Saturday morning at registration and prior to the mandatory Skippers Meeting. When Sailing Instructions are available they will be posted at <http://www.regattatech.com/events/CSC/LaserWinter17> or www.ccsailing.org

8. TROPHIES/PRIZES

Laser Division awards given for top three positions, and Top Junior. Laser Radial Division awards given for top three positions, and top master. Laser 4.7 Division awards given for top three positions.

9. COURSES

Courses will be described in the Sailing Instructions.

10. SCORING

The Low Point System, RRS Appendix A, shall be used. All races shall be counted unless 8 or more have been completed. RRS A2 is modified to reflect that one throw out will be allowed if 8 or more races have been completed

12. GENERAL and FACILITIES

Boats can be stored overnight Saturday on the CSC docks on either Kitty-Hawk type trailers or dollies.

While the facility is gated with code-only access, there is not a security guard on site and the Corinthian Sailing Club will not assume responsibility for property left on the premises. Foot protection is required while on CSC piers.

Corinthian Sailing Club is located within the Dallas Parks Department White Rock Lake Park. Alcoholic beverages are not allowed in the park, however alcoholic beverages are allowed within the gated portion of the Corinthian Sailing Club only. Restrooms, but no showers, are available at the club. Camping is not available, but a wide choice of accommodations is available nearby. With advanced notice we may, on a limited basis, try to house sailors with club members. We may also be able to arrange loaner boats depending upon availability.
