## NOTICE OF RACE

### 1. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

### 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

The regatta is open to all boats of the Sunfish class.

### 3. REGISTRATION AND FEES

3.1. Registration is on-line only at [http://diyc.org/calendar/ai1ec\\_event/fl-state-sunfish-championship/?instance\\_id=](http://diyc.org/calendar/ai1ec_event/fl-state-sunfish-championship/?instance_id=)

3.2. Entry fee is \$55. Add \$10 late fee after April 22.

3.3. Members of US Sailing may deduct \$5.

3.4. No entries will be accepted after 1030 on April 29.

3.5. Entry fee will include regatta favor, two wine /beer /soda tickets, dinner Saturday evening, breakfast Sunday morning, snacks on the water and pizza after racing Sunday.

3.6. Extra meal tickets for Saturday night dinner and/or Sunday breakfast will be available at registration for \$10.

### 5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and supplementary sailing instructions that will be posted on the official notice board located on the West wall of the ground floor of the Clubhouse.

## 6. VENUE

The Venue will be Hillsborough Bay south of Davis Island Yacht Club.

## 7. THE COURSES

The courses will include windward/leeward, triangles or any combination of these. The specific course options and their designations will be diagrammed in the sailing instructions.

## 8. SCORING

8.1. Seven races are scheduled.

8.2. When fewer than six races have been completed a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

8.3. A minimum of one completed race is required to constitute a series.

## 9. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded to the top 5 finishers overall and the first junior.

## 10. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

10.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race.

10.2. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

10.3. Skippers will be required to sign a waiver of liability during check-in.
