

Hello all,

Welcome to Davis Island Yacht Club! For those of you who are visiting us for the first time and those that are returning, we wish you all great breeze, fun times, and warm weather--although that is looking a little iffy!. This letter is meant to provide you with an overview, and we hope that if you have any questions that you will feel free to contact us.

1. Launching procedures: We all know that you want to get your boats in the water and ready for sailing. We want to make that process as easy as possible. Keep in mind that you need to....
  - a. If you are leaving your trailer in one of the storage slips, then you need place your trailer in your slip with enough space to park your vehicle in front of the trailer without blocking the roadway.
  - b. On SUNDAY, we ask that you park your vehicles outside the gate, preferably at the Boat Ramp Parking Lot. You may drop your crew and supplies at or near your boat, and then you will drive out to the parking area. We will have a shuttle for transportation to return to the Club.
  - c. Please make sure that you work with the Club and Regatta volunteers as we help to get you into the water.
  - d. For all boats/trailers, please park your trailers inside the gates of the Club.

2. Hauling Procedures: In order to expedite the haul-out procedure, we will be using the following process.

- a. On Sunday upon arriving at the dock/hoist area, you will send one Member of your crew to secure your trailer. This Member will stay with the trailer as it is moved to the hoist area. One Member will stay with the boat.
- b. As soon as the trailer is ready and in line, then you will be cleared to proceed to the hoist. The boat is then ready to be pulled. After the boat is secured on the trailer, then it is cleared to proceed to the wash station.
- c. After the boat is cleaned, then our Members will provide a vehicle to help to secure the vessel in its slip (if applicable) or off the premises for those departing that afternoon.
- d. Be mindful of the airport when moving vessels with rigs upright.
