NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The Quantum J/70 Winter Series will be governed by the *rules* as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 In addition to other J/70 Class Rules (CR), I.1 (Spare Gennaker) and I.3 (Support Boats) will apply.
- 1.3 Bow identifiers will be assigned by the race committee and given to each participating boat at registration. They shall be affixed to the hull according to the instructions provided by the OA.

2 ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the OA.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 Each Regatta is open to all boats of the J/70 Class that conform to the Class Rules.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form and paying the required fees.
- 3.3 Registration and payment for each Regatta must be completed online at least 24 hours prior to the competitors meeting for that Regatta.
- 3.4 Registrations for each Regatta will be capped at 50 boats. A wait list will be implemented if necessary.
- 3.5 **All participants in each Regatta, including those who registered and made the required payments online, are required to report to the Regatta Registration Desk during the hours it is open to confirm and complete their registration for the Regatta.**

4 CLASSIFICATION

- 4.1 The ISAF Regulation 22, Sailor Classification Code will apply. See www.isaf.org/isafsailor and CR C.3.2.
- 4.2 For Corinthian awards, all helmsmen and all crew shall be current ISAF Group 1 competitors and shall register their ISAF sailor ID and classification via the Regatta website by the end of registration.

5 FEES

- 5.1 The entry fee is US\$160 for each Regatta, if paid prior to 2400 hrs on the following dates:

- 5.2 An additional late fee of \$75 will be due for each Regatta, for a total of \$235, if paid after the above due date and prior to 1900 hrs on the following dates:

- 5.3 The entry fee includes state and local taxes and the following for up to four competitors per boat: breakfast buffet on Saturday and Sunday, heavy snacks on Friday evening and after racing on Saturday, pizza on Sunday and keg beer Friday, Saturday and Sunday.
- 5.4 Additional social packages will be available for purchase at registration.
- 5.5 An entry will not be considered final nor storage confirmed until all fees are paid and all required forms are submitted.
- 5.6 Refund Policy – Competitors shall receive refunds based on withdrawal dates below:

6 ON-SITE REGISTRATION, INSPECTION AND MEASUREMENT

- 6.1 All competitors must complete on-site forms and waivers during registration hours.
- 6.2 Boats and sails are subject to inspection.
- 6.3 Changes or substitution of sails shall be in accordance with CR C.10 and will require the written consent of the race committee.
- 6.4 Changes or substitutions of crew during a Regatta will require written consent of the race committee.
- 6.5 Copies of crew lists for all boats will be available for inspection during registration. Changes to crew lists will be posted on the official notice board.

7 SCHEDULE

- 7.1 There will be no Warning Signal after 1400 on Sunday of each Regatta.
- 7.2 Seven races are scheduled for each Regatta, 21 total races for the Quantum J/70 Winter Series.

8 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at registration and may be posted online on the Quantum J/70 Winter Series web site.

9 LAUNCHING AND MOORAGE

- 9.1 All boats must be in the water by 0800 on the first race day of a Regatta and shall remain in the water until the end of the Regatta, unless granted prior permission by the Race Committee.
- 9.2 Once launched, boats shall not use electricity without consent of the Race Committee.



10 COURSES

The course will be a windward / leeward configuration.

11 SCORING

11.1 For each Regatta:

- i. A boat's Regatta score will be the total of all of her race scores.
- ii. Two completed races are necessary to constitute a Regatta.

11.2 To be scored for the Quantum J/70 Winter Series:

- i. Competitors must register, pay and compete in all three Regattas.
- ii. The helmsman must be the same in all three events.
- iii. The same boat must be used in all three events.
- iv. A boat's Quantum J/70 Winter Series Score will be the total of all of her race scores.

12 PRIZES

12.1 For each Regatta, trophies will be awarded to the top three boats and the top Corinthian team.

12.2 For the overall Winter Series, a trophy will be awarded to the Series winner and the top Corinthian team.

12.3 Additional prizes may be awarded.

13 INSURANCE

13.1 All boats are required to hold adequate third-party insurance (\$300,000.00) and it is the owner or owner representative's sole and inescapable responsibility to ensure that the insurance is in place and is adequate prior to competing in the event.

13.2 Proof of Insurance shall be provided at the time of online registration. Proof of insurance will be required before boat storage is allowed.

14 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Sailing is an activity that carries with it an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors participate in these Regattas entirely at their own risk and are reminded to pay special attention to RRS 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers include the Organizing Authority, The Davis Island Yacht Club, Race Committee, Protest Committee, sponsors, volunteers, or any other affiliated organization or official who will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of practice for or participation in this event during shore side or on-the-water activities. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.

15 ONSITE BOAT STORAGE

There will be space for 35 boats to be stored on the Davis Island Yacht Club property commencing on November 30. A separate storage agreement and fee will be required as well as a storage release/waiver completed. **Boats must be removed from club property no later than February 14, 2016.**
