NOTICE OF RACE

- The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2012-2016 Edition, the prescriptions of US Sailing and Thistle Class Rules.
- Boats shall comply with the Class Rules and the designer and manufacturer's original standards, which shall prevail in the event of conflict.

2 ELIGIBILITY

• Entry is open to all members of the Thistle Class Association who meet the eligibility requirements of the class rules.

3 **REGISTRATION & FEES**

- Competitors MUST register online at
 http://www.regattatech.com/events/SYC/ThistleACC14
 so that the competitors sail numbers can be entered into the online scoring program.
- Entry fee is \$125.00 per boat. Entry fee includes: Hoist launch, haul out, trailer storage, Saturday and Sunday continental breakfast, on the water snacks while racing, and a Saturday evening barbeque for three. There will be Blue Point beer and sodas on tap after racing on Saturday and Sunday.
- Sailors have an option to register for the Sayville YC Lobster Bash Saturday night for an additional \$20. That dinner consists of Lobster or Filet Mignon, corn on the cob, salad, and a yummy desert. There will be a DJ spinning a variety of music for all to hear.
- Sailors that preregister online through Sunday, July 6th, 2014 can order regatta shirts for \$15 per shirt. Please specify size when registering online.
- On-site registration will close at 9:30 am on July 12th, 2014.

4 SCHEDULE OF EVENTS:

Friday, July 11th

600-1900 Registration

Saturday, July 12th

- 0800-0930: Registration and Continental Breakfast.
- 1000: Skippers Meeting.
- 1100: First warning signal, races to follow.
- Five races are scheduled, wind permitting. Barbeque ticket and beverages after racing are included in registration fee.

Sunday, July 13th

- 0800-0930: Continental Breakfast.
- 1000: 1st warning signal, races to follow.
- Three races are scheduled, wind permitting.
- No race shall start after 1500 on Sunday. Awards will follow ASAP after the last race.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS AND COURSES

- The sailing instructions will be available during on-site registration.
- Courses will be posted on the Official Notice Board and specified at the Competitor's Briefing.

• Eight (8) races are scheduled, of which a minimum of three races must be completed to constitute a regatta.

6 SCORING

• The Low Point Scoring System, Appendix A2, will be used except as modified by the sailing instructions.

7 AWARDS

• Trophies will be award for first through fifth places, including crew.

9 DIRECTIONS TO SAYVILLE YACHT CLUB

From the Throgs Neck Bridge, take the Clearview Expressway south to the Long Island Expressway (LIE). Take the LIE east to exit 62 (Rte. 97 - Nicolls Rd) south to the very end and turn right onto Montauk Hwy 27A. Go to 1st light, and take a left at the CVS on to Gillette Ave. Go south 1 mile to blinking light. Take this left on to Middle Road, go two streets to Boylan Lane, turn right, and go to the end. Look for the gated entry on the left. Remember that the "Parkways" of Long Island prohibit trailers. Although cartopping Thistles is permitted on the parkways, some bridges on the parkway system have posted vertical clearances below 8' in height.
